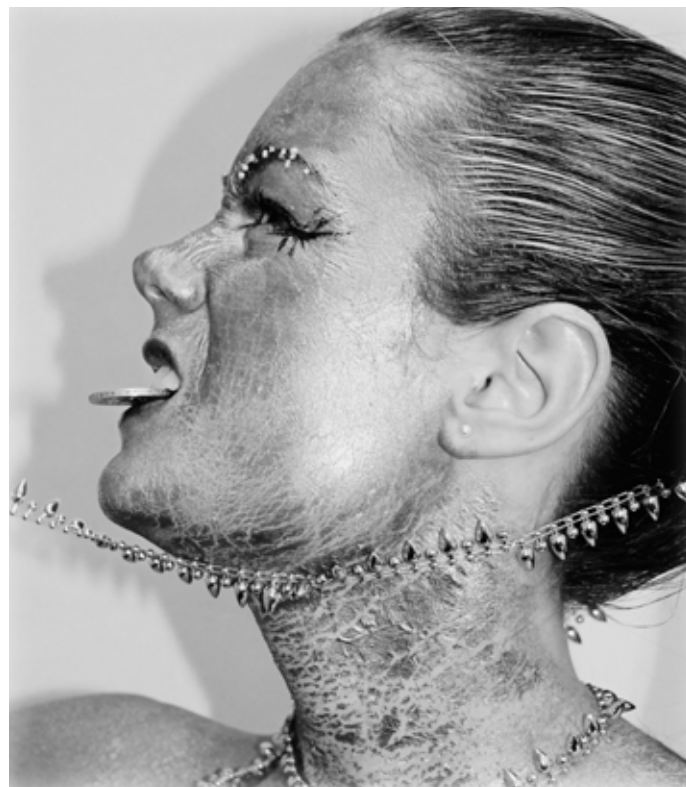


ART, CRAFT & DESIGN AND PHOTOGRAPHY
